



SUB-AWARD BETWEEN CAREER SOURCE HEARTLAND AND SOUTH FLORIDA STATE COLLEGE FOR 2020-21 YEAR-ROUND IN-SCHOOL YOUTH SERVICES

AMENDMENT #2

THIS SUB-AWARD, entered into between CareerSource Heartland (CSH), with administrative offices at 5901 US Hwy 27 S, Suite 1, Sebring, Florida, 33870, and South Florida State College, hereinafter referred to as "Sub-recipient," with administrative offices at 600 W. College Drive, Avon Park, Florida 33825, for the purpose of providing age-appropriate workforce development services to In-School Youth ages 16 to 21 who face serious barriers to employment as authorized by the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA - Public Law 113-128), and Florida's Workforce Innovation Act 2000, Chapter 2000-165 Laws of Florida, and any subsequent amendments, is hereby amended as follows:

- Updating Federal Award Identification Numbers (FAIN) for Welfare Transition Program - Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF)
Updating Total amounts of Federal Awards to CSH

CSH is not obligated, under this Contract, to fully expend contracted amount. Payments will be made through Federal funds from grants with CFDA numbers 17.259 WIOA Youth, and 93.558 TANF, CFDA 17.258 WIOA Adult, and CFDA 17.278 WIOA Dislocated Worker. Contractor acknowledges that the cost data submitted to CSH in support of this contract is accurate, complete, and current as of the date of execution of this amendment.

The contract term remains unchanged, beginning on July 1, 2020 and ending on June 30, 2021. CSH is not obligated to pay for costs incurred related to this contract prior to the begin date or after the end date.

All other terms and conditions of the contract remain unchanged.
